





# BIOGRAPHY

Me-Lee Hay resonates with tones that evokes beauty with danger composing for film, TV, dance and theatre. A Malaysian born Chinese-Australian, Hay was been nominated for an AACTA Award for Best Original Score in Film (*Suka*) in 2024.

Hay has had works shown across many platforms including Australian TV channels SBSOne, TEN, and Seven to Netflix Australia, and international planetariums. Off screen Hay has been commissioned by leading arts companies of Australia such as Sydney Dance Company's PPY & Sydney Theatre Company.

Hay is a graduate of the Australian Film Television & Radio School (AFTRS) and is an Associate Composer represented by the Australian Music Centre. With a training in classical piano (A.Mus.A), cello and theory, combined with electronica/pop explorations in the touring live band scene, she is attracted to sounds of classical textures merging seamlessly with sounds and ambience of the modern world to facilitate a story, emotion and creation of worlds. Me-Lee was a Board director and then the Vice President of the Australian Guild of Screen Composers for 5 years.

Screen credits include co-composer for feature film *A Second Chance Rivals!* (Netflix top ten children's category in June 2021 release), SBSOne cooking show series *Luke Nguyen* and Museum Victoria's dome astronomy documentaries

**Starlight** and **Capturing the Cosmos** (narrated by Sigrid Thornton and Geoffrey Rush respectively). She scored for USA produced documentary **Finding Her Beat** which screened at over 40 festivals before being released on on streaming platforms.

Me-Lee's score for the multiple award winning fantasy 30 minute film *Last Tree Standing (2017)*, which premiered at **Sitges** Film Festival, won **Best Music** for a Short Film at Australia's prestigious APRA Screen Music Awards as well as Best Music at Iowa's Motion Picture Awards. Other short film hi-lites include *Cut Off (2018) and Golem (2021)* both premiering at **Monster Fest** whilst Golem featured in opening night at **St Kilda Film Festival** along with a raft of other festivals worldwide.

Additionally, Me-Lee has also worked in the music department of multiple feature films including the Christmas horror film **Better Watch Out** (choir arranger, composer assistant) **Science Fiction Vol.1 The Osiris Child** (composer assistant) and **Penelopa** (additional music to Max Richter).
